

ESB2 Quick-Start Cheat Sheet

Unit Set-up:

- 1) Remove all contents from packaging
- 2) Extend the tripod to the desired height of 26-30 inches
- 3) Attach the magnetic mount to the top of the tripod via threaded screw (make sure the bracketed side is facing up)
- 4) Turn the magnetic rings to a 90-degree angle to the mount. One will be turned up and the other will turn down (Make sure the magnetic side of the rings are facing outwards)
- 5) Attach the ESB2 to the lower of the two magnets via the metal plate on the back of the unit
- 6) Set the tripod 4-6 feet behind the ball and orient so that the ESB2 is directly facing the hitting area
- 7) Using the button on the right side of the unit, TURN ON the unit (you will see a small green light on the far right of the three lights on the front of the unit)

Phone and App Set-up:

- 1) Download the ESRRange app from the Apple app store
- 2) WATCH INSTRUCTIONAL VIDEO (Video is from a slightly older version of the app but the instructions are all still correct) *We will have an updated video coming shortly*
- 3) Using the magnetic capabilities of your phone, attach it to the magnetic mount on the higher side (same as wireless/magnetic charging)
- 4) Open ESRRange app to main page and select “**Start Session**”
- 5) Once prompted, pair to the ESB2 through the Bluetooth selection menu (it will be labeled ESB1)
- 6) By tapping the “**Club Name**” tab in the middle of the screen, you can scroll through the club list and select which club you wish to use (make sure to press “Send” at the bottom of the screen)

Video Portion Set-up:

- 1) Along the bottom of the screen, your tabs are listed as follows: Session, GPS, Video, Data, and Settings. Tap on the **Video** tab to open the video-portion of the app
- 2) The red box that is displayed on your screen is the “Ball Recognition Zone” and this is where the ball must be located before hitting

- 3) Once your unit and phone are set up properly, you can start hitting balls. The video will auto-record and will save automatically into your “**Data**” section
- 4) Under the “Data” section, enter the “**Session Logs**” tab. This will bring up every shot hit on your unit. Your videos will save and appear as a camera outline next to your shot data
- 5) Tap on the camera outline icon and this will start the video-processing. Allow the video processing to conclude in its entirety and it will show you the finished video!
- 6) Once processed, two additional icons will appear with your shot data. The filled-in cloud icon is where your finished video is stored. You can view it anytime by tapping that icon
